

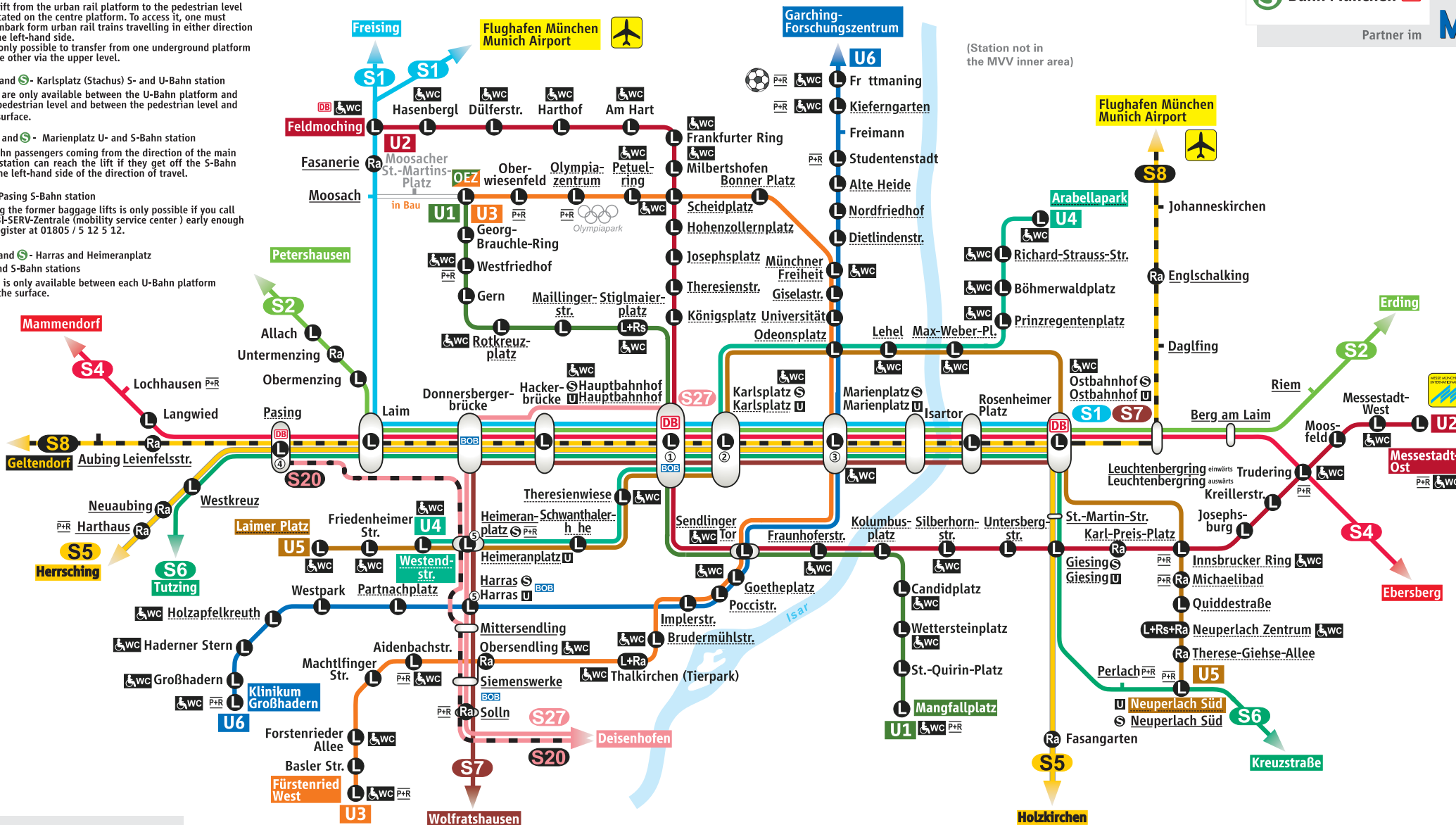


S-Bahn and U-Bahn barrier-free travel availability in the city

- U and S station at the Central Station**
The lift from the urban rail platform to the pedestrian level is located on the centre platform. To access it, one must disembark from urban rail trains travelling in either direction on the left-hand side.
It is only possible to transfer from one underground platform to the other via the upper level.
- U- and S- Karlsplatz (Stachus) S- and U-Bahn station**
Lifts are only available between the U-Bahn platform and the pedestrian level and between the pedestrian level and the surface.
- U- and S- Marienplatz U- and S-Bahn station**
S-Bahn passengers coming from the direction of the main rail station can reach the lift if they get off the S-Bahn on the left-hand side of the direction of travel.
- S- Pasing S-Bahn station**
Using the former baggage lifts is only possible if you call MOBI-SERV-Zentrale (mobility service center) early enough to register at 01805 / 5 12 5 12.
- U- and S- Harras and Heimeranplatz U- and S-Bahn stations**
A lift is only available between each U-Bahn platform and the surface.



(Station not in the MVV inner area)

Key:

- L** Lift
- WC** WC for the disabled
- Rs** Escalator
- P+R** MVV car park
- Ra** Ramp

Indication of the difference between the platform and vehicle levels:
For example:

Harthof	Difference	2 - 7 cm
Scheidplatz	Difference	8 - 13 cm
Westkreuz	Difference	24 - 30 cm

The tramways employed on the following lines have low access heights:
12, 15, 16, 17, 18, 20, 21, 25, 27, N17, N19, N20, N27

Most buses employed on urban bus lines have low access heights and boarding aids.

What side to get off at the mainline urban rail stations
Get off on the left-hand side at Rosenheimer Platz, Isartor und Hackerbrücke stations.
Get off on the right-hand side at Marienplatz, Karlsplatz und Hauptbahnhof stations.
See ① and ③ for exceptions.
At Ostbahnhof, Donnersbergerbrücke, Laim and Pasing stations the side you get off varies due to changing operational needs.

What side to get off at the underground stations
You normally get off on the left-hand side.
At the following stations you have to get off on the right-hand side:
U1 Kolumbusplatz (outward bound, if not a terminal station)
U2 Scheidplatz, Hauptbahnhof, Kolumbusplatz (outwards), Innsbrucker Ring

U3 Implerstraße
U4 Max-Weber-Platz, Richard-Strauß-Straße
U5 Max-Weber-Platz (outwards from the city)
U6 Kieferngarten (outwards), Nordfriedhof, Münchener Freiheit, Implerstraße (outwards)
At the terminal station the side you get off varies due to changing operational needs.
